This song came alive recently as I witnessed 8year-olds coming forward with their parents to talk about what it means to be a Christ follower. Using the Apostles' Creed and sharing with the congregation that the "stuff" named in the Creed is what sets our tradition apart, that we carry this beautiful and heavy teaching TOGETHER. Together, we confess our faith. Together, we are curious. Together we are changed by the Word of Life, Jesus in the flesh, and the joys and sorrows we share.

"What is the meaning of life?" I have been asked this question countless times. To find joy in serving others, to be connected to God, others and creation, was my response recently. Sometimes it can feel like our life's longings and dreams, pains and joys are all disjointed pieces, we can't make out a pattern. Jesus is the one who holds all things together. Jesus is the key to all the fragments of our life coming together into a whole.

People try to find meaning through success or even through things that can become addictions and destroy our lives. When Jesus is our friend and Savior and connects us to others in community, we find a deep peace and contentment. Trusting that Jesus is truly with us, we face our problems and tasks differently. We discover a joy that eluded us before. As Dan Erlander puts it: "Jesus had a name for those who follow God's way of loving even enemies. They are called sons and daughters of God which means IMITATORS of the divine life" (Manna and Mercy, page 46). God smiles when we become partner people, empowered by God's Spirit and recipients of the extravagant compassion of Christ.

Easter season prayer

We pray for those whose lives are at critical crossroads: where decisions are clouded by conflicting demands: where courage is required through uncertain times.

We pray for those at the turning points of life: where changes in relationships, changes in family, changes in schooling, changes in employment, changes in health, changes in capabilities, changes in faith cause chaos and bring uncertainty.

We pray for these crises: for patient wisdom to be exercised and fear for change tempered by trust in your promised presence whatever we face.

We thank you, God, for the gift of your Spirit

which binds our brokenness, brings us courage and helps us face all we might otherwise fear.

We pray for those whose lives feel as if they are on hold the future fearful, the present tearful: as if boundaries have closed in, options closed off and what to do and to be is for now unclear.

We pray for the church that it be a haven of calm, a source of healing, a place of space and time where truth can be discerned, trust shown and confidence grown for life, in faith, with love. Amen


Endowment Committee
