C.S. Lewis is known to have said: "I believe in Christ as I believe that the sun has risen not only because I see it, but because <u>by it</u>, I see everything else".

Recently our confirmation students discussed "The Hard Sayings of Jesus". They read through several of his teachings and rated them by which is the most difficult to follow and live out as a teen today, to which is the least difficult. Several chose Matthew 5:44 as the most difficult: "Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you". One group chose Matthew 5:48 "Be perfect (complete), therefore, as your heavenly Father is perfect (complete)". Other verses were Mark 10:25: "It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for someone who is rich to enter the kingdom of God" and Matthew 5:39: "But I say to you: Do not resist an evildoer. But if anyone strikes you on the right cheek, turn the other also".

We wondered about the changes that would occur in our home life and in our country if Jesus' hard sayings were followed and lived out.

It is good to wrestle with Jesus' teachings and our questions about life and faith. Jesus came to save you from your sins, not your questions. Doubt often leads to a stronger faith. Don't be afraid of hard questions. God is big enough to handle our tough questions. We are meant to work through these questions together. Faith in Christ Jesus is a team sport. Good questions can lead us to dig deeper, to seek, to search. Jesus promises all who seek will find. All who knock will find doors opened.

Maybe you are wondering who God is. Jesus shows us.

Jesus said, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me". (John 14:8).

Jesus spoke to them, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness but will have the light of life." (John 8:12)

Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. Those who believe in me, even though they die, will live. (John 11:25)

You are invited to be part of the celebrations this month as we celebrate the Sunday school kids and teachers and confirmation guides on May 5th, recognize graduating seniors on May 12th, and most importantly, witness the Affirmation of Baptism for 9 remarkable students on May 19th. Our Saturday worship community will rejoice in baby Tate's baptism on May 18th, and we will be preparing for the fun and active learning that is Vacation Bible School.

A prayer inspired by Paul's words to the Thessalonians:

Every time we think of each other, may we thank you, O God,

for the community we are becoming and the place each of us has, as a Child of God. May we pray for each other,

keeping in mind each other's belonging through faith

and labor of love.

May we support each other in following you and we see your love through each other knowing each is blessed with holy gifts: a blessing to the world.

May our lives be an imitation of Jesus and despite trouble in the world and confusion all around may we be a light as your people, always. Amen.

HIGHLIGHTS FROM Sunday, April 14th, 2024, Church Council meeting

Old Business: None

New Business: Change to the constitution to allow Nominating Committee to serve for more than 1 year. We can do that with a continuing resolution to be ratified by the congregation at the annual meeting. The proposed change will keep a 1-year term but make it eligible for up to 3 consecutive years. Judy Nelson moved; Pastor Jolene seconded to change the verbiage.

A Nominating Committee of at least three voting members of this congregation, one or two of whom, if possible, shall be outgoing members of the congregational council, shall be elected at the annual meeting for a term of one year. Members of the Nominating Committee are eligible for consecutive reelection with a maximum of 3 years.

Request received to give a donation to Synod Assembly. A request will be written for \$500 Endowment funds for that.

Business: Reviewed distributions and balances.

Education: "Full VBS mode" and in need of donations and lots of help for all roles. Will post a signup sheet listing openings for VBS. 3 members going to Council retreat.

Membership: Looking for a 10x10 canopy to use at Wednesdays on Broadway; also would like to offer some kind of handouts to give visitors. Considering hosting an after-church event (meal) in the future. All members plan to attend Council retreat.

Property: Working on ideas for the bathroom remodel. Chancel lights have been updated. Fascia will be replaced instead of painted.

Worship: Easter went well; looking at special music in August. Songs & S'mores plans are going ahead for June and July.

Youth: Looking into helping with cleanup at the cemetery – not this year (already done due to recent rain) but in the future.
